1) All application documents must arrive on or before the deadline(~17:00 P.M./KST) and the application fee shall be paid within the deadline.

2) Jeonju University will not return any submitted documents. If applicants submit inaccurate, conflicting, misleading, or false documents, the University reserves the right to cancel their admission.

3) If any required documents are missing during the screening process, the application will be withdrawn.

4) The University shall not be held responsible for any negative consequences resulting from typos in the application documents or an applicant's failure to respond during the interview process.

12. IMPORTANT NOTE FOR APPLICANT

 All notices and admission announcement shall be posted on the University's website
 All applicants must be present in the waiting room at least half an hour before the interview. They will be informed about the interview procedures.

3) All applicants must be aware of the admission process before taking the examination.

4) The University will take action against applicants who engage in misconduct.

① Applicants must follow the instructions given by interviewers and committee members and must not disturb other applicants during the admission process.

② Applicants are not allowed to take the admission process on behalf of others.

③ It is strictly prohibited to share or cheat on answer sheets during the examination.
④ Applicants must not engage in conversation during the test or complete their answer sheets using mobile phones or other electronic devices.

(5) Submitting false documents or engaging in any misconduct recognized by interviewers or committee members is strictly prohibited.

5) If applicants fail to comply with these rules and it negatively affects the process, the University shall not be held responsible for any consequences.

6) The University reserves the right to refund the application fee under the following conditions: ① In case that applicants pay an application fee more than KRW 50,000 (Exceeded amount to be refunded)

② If an applicant is unable to attend the admission process due to University-related reasons, a full refund will be provided.

③ If an applicant is unable to attend the admission process due to a natural disaster, a full refund will be provided.

④ If an applicant is unable to attend the admission process due to an unexpected illness, accident, hospitalization, or death, a full refund will be provided upon submission of official proof.
